- Finalists are to perform a choice of one of their examination level variations.

- Entrants should wear examination leotard and tights and hair styled as per the exam (shoes as per examination specifications) Intermediate to Advanced 2 levels must wear Demi-pointes.
- Light make up may be worn—NO jewellery
- Finalists have the option of wearing a half tutu for Variation 1 and a chiffon skirt for Variation 2 in the finals
- Grade 4/5 finalists will wear examination attire.
