

Teaching Certificate in 1988, Karen enjoyed a performance career in various styles of dance, followed by teaching in her own dance schools in N.S.W. and QLD. She then freelanced in both Australia and London, teaching at The Ballet School in Notting Hill, West London School of Dance and Anna Pavlova's Ivy House.
