Rebecca Jorgensen (Lyrical) is a qualified RAD teacher and has a Bachelor of Fine Arts (Dance Performance) and Masters of Primary Teaching. She also has extensive elite gymnastics training and has a strong understanding of student individuality and assisting dancers to reach their potential.

Nina Green (Contemporary) is a young performer who has trained and studied at the highly acclaimed Ev and Bow Full Time Dance Training Center and has performed under some of Australia's best and well known choreographers and mentors in the industry.

Marcus Pearce (Jazz Group) - Marcus is the Manager of Conroy Performing Arts College and a senior teacher and choreographer at the Conroy Dance Centre. His career spans over 15 years, having worked in Asia, the USA, Europe and Australia.

Natalie Hammond (Classical) – Natalie won critical acclaim for a variety of senior roles when dancing with Queensland Ballet and has spent time with World Dance Company. More recently she joined 2ballerinas adult dance school and worked on music videos for the band Sheppard and Hayden James.
