



Terms and Conditions

Prelude Masterclass, Sunday 13 March 2022

- Entries are via Trybooking only and close Monday 7 March 2022 at 8am or when classes have reached 25 students per class. The entry fee is non-refundable and late entries cannot be accepted.
- Students must be fully clothed and wearing shoes before they leave the venue.
- Name tags are supplied to the students attending and should be worn at all times.
- RAD should be notified in writing of any medical conditions when enrolling students in the Masterclass. Students participate at their own risk.
- The information is correct at time of publication and RAD reserves the right to make any changes where necessary, without notice.
- A 50% refund is *only* available if a written request is made and accompanied by a medical certificate prior to closing date, Monday 7 March 2022 at 8am, outlining that the student can no longer attend. Entry fee is non-refundable after that date or in other instances.
- Unless otherwise directed by the parent/guardian it is accepted that photographic images taken during this course may be used for RAD promotional/reporting purposes.
