We are seeking a canteen service to provide:

- A selection of healthy and nutritious lunch, dinner, snacks and beverage options for entrants, patrons, volunteers and RAD staff at fair and reasonable prices for the duration of the Festival of Dance (dates and times below)
- Healthy and nutritious lunch, dinner, afternoon and morning tea options for Adjudicators throughout the Festival as scheduled
- An ability to provide an organised service compliant with safety guidelines including food preparation, handling and storage
- An ability to provide an service compliant with COVID-19 safety procedures and recommended guidelines

The WA Regional Advisory Panel agrees to the following terms:

- The WA Regional Advisory Panel will call for Expressions of Interests each year.
- The WA Regional Advisory Panel will consider all Expressions of Interests on the ability to meet the above criteria.
- Successful applicants will provide the canteen service on an annual rotation. For example; School 1 and School 2 both provide a successful EOI, one school will be selected to provide the canteen in that year. If both schools successfully apply the following year, School 2 will provide the canteen in that year.
- The RAD Regional Advisory Panel does not receive any income from the canteen; all monies raised are retained by the canteen organising group.
- A record of RAD staff and volunteer purchases should be maintained throughout the weekend and a final invoice should be sent to the WA Regional Advisory Panel for payment. This should also include meals for the Adjudicators.
