

- Entries are via Trybooking only and close when classes reach 25 students per class or at 8am Tuesday 28 June 2022.
- The entry fee is non-refundable for change-of-mind, bookings are not transferable and late entries cannot be accepted.
- Students should attend all classes for their level, and part-payment or part-refunds are not possible for any days missed.
- Ideally students attending the course should have a sound knowledge of the syllabus and
 their chosen variations, however we understand due to circumstances this year that may
 not always be possible. Students are welcome to attend as long as they can copy/follow
 along with the other students and don't expect to be taught the syllabus this course is
 for final exam preparation.
- Students are to wear examinations attire in all classes, and props should be used for dances where applicable.
- Name tags are supplied to the students attending and should be worn in a visible location.
- Students must be fully clothed and wearing shoes before they leave the venue.
- A refund is only available if a written request is made and accompanied by a medical
 certificate prior to 5:00pm on the day prior to the course start date, outlining that the
