Classes are taken by Royal Academy of Dance examiners and/or tutors and focus on coaching the syllabus. Classes are available for Intermediate Foundation and above. Students should have a good knowledge of the syllabus and their chosen variations in order to gain the most benefit from attending. Examination uniform is required for all classes.

Conditions of entry

- Entries close Tuesday 4 April 2023 or when classes have reached 25 students per class.
- Each student will need to have a name tag (supplied by the RAD) on their leotard at all times.
- Unless otherwise directed by the parent/guardian it is accepted that photographs taken during this course may be used for RAD promotional/reporting purposes.
- Students should attend all classes for their level, and part payment or part refunds are not possible for any days or classes missed.
- Entry fees due to withdrawal are non-refundable unless a written request is made to the Event Organiser.
- Refunds will only be made in accordance with the following terms:
- Withdrawals made prior to the advertised event closing date will incur a 10% administration fee.
- Withdrawals made after the closing date and prior to the event will be refunded 50% on presentation of a medical certificate.
- No refunds will be made for non-attendance on any day of the event.
- The Academy reserves the right to alter the advertised program and/or faculty without prior notice. The information in this and other printed or electronic brochures, notices were correct at the time of issuing.
- Students are required to wear shoes and appropriate clothing when not in class when arriving and departing from venue.
